- Supporting free trade agreements based on fairness and reciprocity to allow small businesses to tap markets abroad

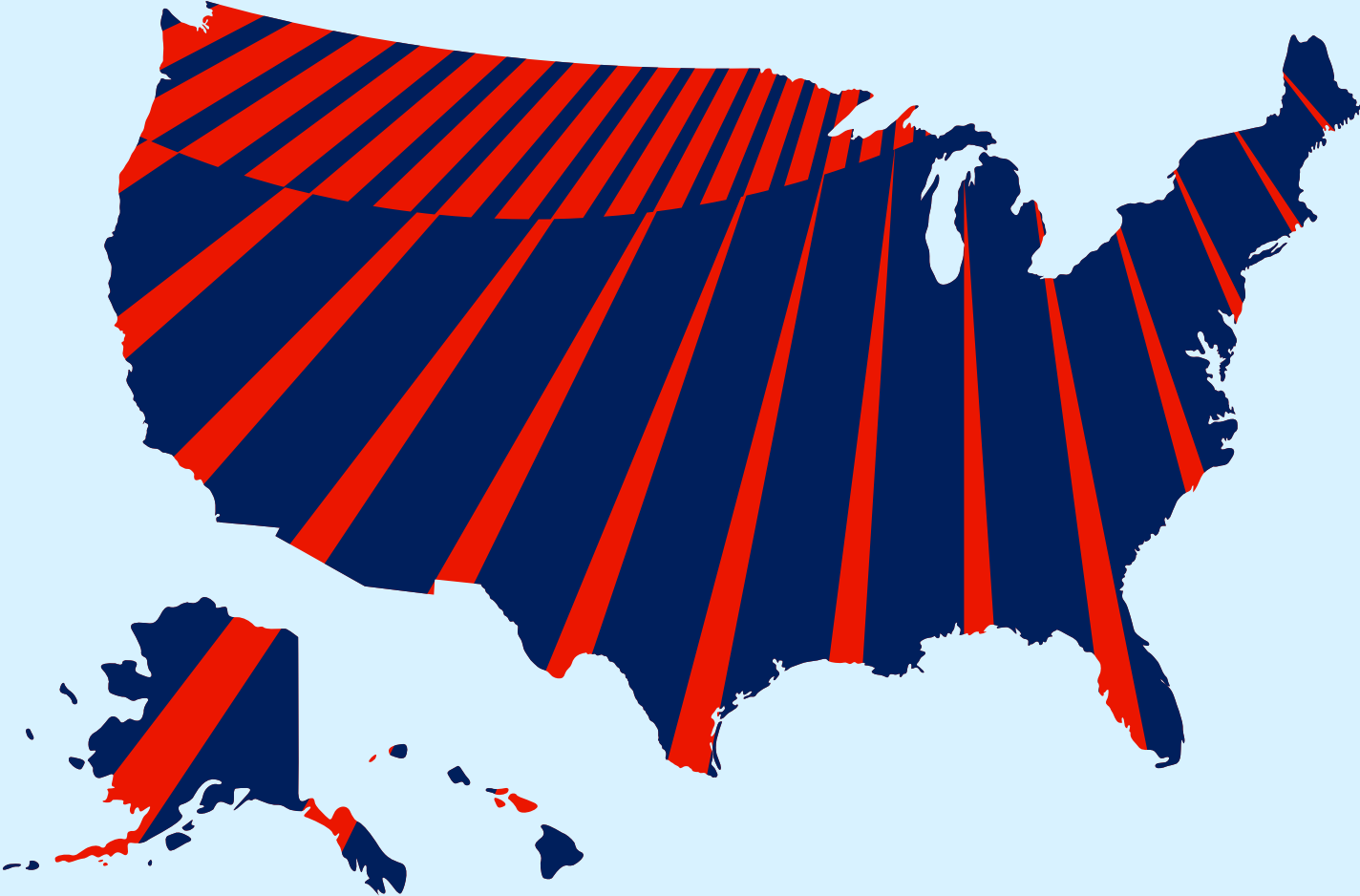
## Legal
