Trade Means Growth for Rhode Island

International trade—exports and imports of goods and services—supports 140,000 jobs in Rhode Island, or about 1 in 5 total jobs in the state.

Key facts about trade and jobs:

- · The share of Rhode Island jobs supported by trade has more than doubled since the early 1990s.
- Jobs in export-intensive industries offer compensation that averages about 16 percent higher than other jobs.
- · Imports let American families stretch their budgets and help U.S. manufacturers keep costs down and competitiveness up.
- · Over 2,000 Rhode Island companies exported in 2022. Nationally, 97% of trading firms are small-and medium sized enterprises.
- · Since 2008, companies that import or export goods have accounted for 3 out of 5 new American jobs.

Rhode Island companies exported \$5.1 billion in goods and services in 2023 to more than 160 markets around the world.



America's FTA partners account for just 6% of the world's population but purchased 41% of Rhode Island's goods exports in 2023.

Rhode Island's goods exports to Ireland were \$247 million in 2023, a 250% increase since 2014.

Canada was the top export market for services exports in 2023 at \$227 million.

Rhode Island's total goods and services exports increased by \$905 million (22%) between 2014 and 2023.

In 2023, Rhode Island exported \$2.9 billion in goods and \$2.2 billion in services — a 10-year high for each.

Most services export growth has been driven by digital trade, which is allowing more Rhode Island companies to reach customers abroad more easily.

Rhode Island's top travel services exports in 2023 were personal travel (\$418 million) and travel for education (\$325 million).

Rhode Island's top food and agricultural exports in 2023 were miscellaneous food items (\$54 million) and squid (\$21 million).

Rhode Island's exports of digitally tradable services reached \$1.1 billion in 2023.

Foreign-headquartered companies directly employ 31,400 Rhode Island workers.

British-owned companies employ the most Rhode Island workers (5,200), followed by French-owned companies (4,400).

Each job at a foreign-owned company typically supports three other U.S. jobs indirectly.

In 2021, U.S. affiliates of foreign-owned companies employed 8 million Americans, exported \$412 billion in goods, and spent \$78 billion on R&D.
